
Sue has been painting for more than 15 years and was one of four artists nominated Painter of the Year by the Academy of Fine Art Foundation in southern California in 2003.

What Can I Expect To Learn?

You will learn by watching and DOING. This class is designed to teach you composition, color theory, brushstroke techniques, sketching and drawing Techniques and basic art history.

There will be some lecturing but mostly in the form of coaching and inspiring you to develop the innate creativity that is unique to you.

Various styles of painting will be introduced including impressionisms, abstract, and expressionism, plein air.

This class is not only good for committed beginners but also for experienced painters who wish to unblock creativity, develop skills further, or come and paint in an uplifting group setting.

When and Where?

The class is an ongoing class. However, the number of students per class is low. Currently classes are held on Thursday 6:30 - 9:00 pm; and Saturday 9:00 - 11:00 am. If Saturdays are your preference I suggest you apply as soon as possible . . it fills the quickly.

You also may attend one, two, or three classes per week.

What Do I Need To Start?

All beginner students are required to commit to at least five classes to start. This is to make sure you give yourself a fair chance. Classes are offered at \$130/5 class series. Thereafter one may pay per class at \$30.00 each. Private sessions are also offered at \$60.00/hour. This may be desired occasionally to develop individual Style.

The initial fee for starter supplies is \$160.00 (10 basic colors, palette box and paper, charcoal set). The color wheel is an additional \$20. This fee DOES NOT include brushes, cleaning supplies, canvas, sketch paper. However, these items will be available for purchase in the studio as needed.

Easels will be provided in the studio for student use, however, you may wish to purchase later on for home or plein air sessions.
